

**2020 Washington State School Retirees Association, WSSRA, Scholarships Description

This application form is for all WSSRA scholarships.**

The following scholarships will be awarded by Region E-7 of WSSRA which is roughly the same geographic area of NEWESD 101: the Whitman County Retired Educators Association, Unit 33; the Pend Oreille County Retired Educators Association, Unit 18; and the Spokane Area Retired Educators Association, Unit 25, Representing Spokane County and all the at-large School districts in ESD 101:

**Two (2) graduating seniors** from the above mentioned area will receive the **PEMCO/Robert J. Handy Scholarship (\$900 per year for up to four years)**. PEMCO Foundation, Inc. administers the funds for the Robert J. Handy Scholarships.

**One (1) graduating high school recipient will receive the WSSRA Foundation Scholarship (\$2,500 for one year).**

**One (1) applicant will be designated as an Alternate** should any of the above recipients be disqualified the Alternate shall receive that Scholarship.

**One (1) current college student shall be the recipient of the Neil D. Prescott Scholarship (\$1,000 for one year)**. The Neil D. Prescott Scholarship is administered by the WSSRA Foundation.

**All of the applicants must meet these requirements:**

1. The application must be completed for the current year (2020).
2. The application Check List must be dated and signed.
3. The application must show an intention to pursue a career in the education field or related field.
4. All requested documents are submitted with the application, placed in a file folder that has been labeled as requested, and mailed in a large envelop to the correct District Representative.
5. The application packet must be post marked no later than March 1, 2020.
