To make this art I used watercolor pencils and normal colored pencils for the finer lines and detail. When creating this piece, I knew I wanted to use watercolor to create a landscape with bright colors, so I found a photograph that I took that I loved and started from there. I drew everything out in lead pencil, then watercolor pencil, and then painted water over the top and finished it with colored pencil on fine lines and details. With this painting, I am trying to give an aesthetic and calming mood for when people view my art to when they look at it, their eyes just flow through the painting. The reasoning for choosing this picture of this specific sunset to paint was because this is a place I like to go to Spokane to just sit and feel calm and a sense of tranquility. Something I could possibly do to improve my work would be to add more simple detail with colored pencil after I was done water coloring, but then it wouldn't have the same simple and non-harsh lines look that I was going for, it would have sharper and more geometric lines.
